Create a 90 sec. to 4 min. video to inspire your peers about the importance of an education. Some themes you might consider:

- · Importance of graduation

- How education prepares you for the jobs of the future

Cyberbullying

Create a 90 sec. to 4 min. video highlighting the importance of positivity and kindness in a world where many young people face bullying. Some themes you might consider:

- How can mobile phones be used to spread positivity and kindness
- Importance of stepping in to help others when they are facing bullying

Preventing Distracted Driving

Create a 90 sec. to 4 min. video to remind your peers why it's important not to drive distracted. Some themes you might consider:

- How everyone in a car has a responsibility to make sure a driver isn't distracted
- Nothing on a cell phone is more important than safe driving
